



## 2026 THRILL SHOW CAR RULES

**TEAMS ARE REQUESTED TO READ ALL RULES, if you are unclear of anything ask track officials**

1. Street Hardtop vehicles, no T-Tops. Sunroofs must be covered using; minimum 22-gauge sheet metal securely fastened in place.
2. **Any automobile no older than 1975 allowed. EXCEPT: No Convertibles, Limos, Hearses & Full-size wagons, No Cadillac's over 115" WB, No Lincolns up to 1980. No Full-size Pontiacs, Buick's & Oldsmobile up to 1976. No Ford LTD's up to 1982. No full-size Dodge/Chrysler/Plymouth up to 1978. ELIGIBLE: Mini vans and compact wagons permitted. No SUV, Jeeps or Vans any size. No Electric or Hybrid cars allowed. ALL body parts, Doors, Fenders, Trunk, Hood etc., MUST be intact to compete.**
3. Drivers must be 18 years old and have a valid driver's license.
4. Only a FULL-SIZE HELMET WITH EYE PROTECTION PERMITTED. OEM safety belts must be used or can be replaced with racing harness. **Drivers must wear a shirt, LONG PANTS and fully enclosed shoes.** Head/Neck restraints are recommended.
5. Battery - If relocated - Must be enclosed in a case and secured to passenger's side floor ONLY. Keep cables from sharp edges!
6. ALL Glass and Upholstery removed - Including rugs and headliners. Front seats may remain. Windshield must remain or replaced with full Lexan, cracked windshield ok if driver can still see. Recommended to remove center console to give driver more room.
7. Bumpers and body must remain stock. No cutting fenders. No towing brackets, latches, or bars allowed that stick out under bumpers. **All cars must have original bumpers. Two (2) chains (¼ min) must be used separately at each end and wrap around bumpers tightly connecting to the chassis this is to prevent bumpers and covers from coming off. Required on ALL cars front & rear. The plastic bumper covers can be removed and are not required but chains still must be in place. This is Mandatory!**
8. All exterior moldings, lighting fixtures, mirrors, front grills, and hub caps must be removed. If it's plastic and can be removed, it needs to come off. **Cars must be clean of debris or will not compete!**
- No broken GLASS inside doors or anywhere else or they will not be allowed to compete!** Trunks must be clean with no trash.
9. Gas tanks may remain in stock location. If relocated, the original tank cannot be used. Only small gas tanks of 5 gallons or less, Boat tanks preferred and must be relocated to inside the trunk area ONLY! Secured properly. A sheet metal wall separating the trunk and drivers compartment mandatory if tank is relocated. Fuel lines must travel under the car only. No more than ½ tank fuel allowed.
10. Rollover bars permitted; bars must be welded/bolted in place. No bars allowed outside of car or into trunk/engine compartments.
11. Exhaust may be cut, must travel past driver under car, NO exhaust may exit outside of car or in driver's compartment. Exhaust may exit straight up from hood, Minimum of 6 inches high from hood line.
12. ALL SAFETY AIR BAGS must be REMOVED. Don't forget to disconnect impact sensors that will shut the car off.
13. Doors MUST be chained 5/16 minimum link size or welded shut, NO rope or straps. The driver's door must be padded inside.
14. Numbers must be painted on both sides of car and must be 24 inches high and 3 inches wide. (Any number permitted). ALL numbers must be clearly visible to score. If it can't be read it can't be scored.
15. Air-Cleaner & Element MUST REMAIN. NO ANTI-FREEZE ALLOWED, Water ONLY. Strictly enforced!
16. Hood - Five-inch hole MUST be placed in hood for access in case of fires. No weight may be added to any vehicle. Hood must be chained/strapped with access to release available. Car will be blacked flagged out of event if hood opens during race. Intake for engines may exhaust through hood. Air intake may come through hood must have screen.
17. **Drivers must NOT tear up the infield or track surfaces by smoking the tires or driving on rims – Drivers can be removed from events and banned from future events if they fail to obey this or any track rules.**
18. Tires not ALLOWED bias ply racing tires, re-caps, or studded. Tires MUST HAVE A MS SYMBOL (Mud & Snow) shown on the sidewall or a TREADWEAR rating of no less than 250. Wheel weights MUST be removed.
19. NO PARTICIPANTS ARE ALLOWED TO CONSUME ANY BEER OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. The police will evict anyone doing so. Violators will also be refused to compete in future events.
20. Sign-in for all events are on a first-come basis. There is a cutoff of 125 cars (does not include full size trucks). Registrations can be done online.

**EVENT RULES: All drivers must follow the direction of Track personal at all times. The drivers must be alerted to track flags and warning lights and obey them immediately**

**ALL DRIVERS MUST ATTEND SCHEDULED DRIVERS' MEETING IN PITS. SEE POSTED SCHEDULE FOR TIME.**

**NOTICE: Information on claiming cars at end on show:**

1. No stripping of vehicles allowed on Speedway grounds. **Cars MUST arrive ready to compete.**
2. Only the registered car owner with claim ticket can take cars off the premises within a 45-minute period after conclusion of show.
3. Cars remaining on premises after the 45-minute period WILL become the property of Seekonk Speedway.
4. The grounds WILL be PROMPTLY CLEARED after the show - NO LOITERING will be allowed. Parking lots must be cleared.
