

2024 SPECTATOR DRAG RULES

- 1. Cars must be registered with **DMV** with a current inspection sticker (if state required). **No dealer, repair, or temp plates**. The body must be street legal using STOCK chassis. No KIT cars. No convertibles (even with roll bar) High performance models of SUV's and trucks up to ½ Ton permitted.
- 2. All Tires must have 2/32nds or better tread depth across face of tire. No Slicks or racing recaps. TREAD WEAR RATING MAY NOT BE BELOW 100. AWD cars must use TREAD WEAR NO LOWER THAN 300. Tread wear must be clearly marked on the tire by the manufacturer or tires will not be eligible for use. No tire stagger permitted (meaning different size tires Left to Right). No tire softeners/treatments permitted, if found to be used you will not be allowed to compete in future events. Tires must fit under body. (Only one axle may extend 1- inch MAX past outer lip of body) No setups for circle track racing, suspension must be neutral.
- 4. Participants must have a <u>valid</u> driver's license and be at least **18 years of age**.
- 5. Helmets FULL FACE HELMET MUSY BE WORN WITH EYE PROTECTION. Seat belts must be worn. Racing seat belt recommended.
- 6. Cars must have front & rear windows and side door windows in place. Interiors may not be stripped (Seats and panels must be in place. Headliner & rugs may be removed). No items may be left in cars that do not belong.

No computers/laptops. No ballast or similar objects.

- 7. No NITROUS even if disconnected. NOS bottles **NOT** allowed, or car will not run. The track has the right to have any equipment removed that gives an unfair advantage or is deemed dangerous to race with.
- 8. All cars must be clean and in good appearance. The track has the right to refuse cars. Cars must arrive NO LATER than ½ Hour before show starts. Vehicles must be inspected to race in any event.

Maximum car count 80 all events. ALL CARS SHOULD PER-REGISTER FOR SHOWS ON TRACK WEBSITE, this does not guarantee a spot if you are late.

<u>DRIVERS MUST ATTEND DRIVERS' MEETING OR THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO</u> COMPETE.

The rules and/or regulations set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of racing events and to establish minimum acceptable requirements for such events, these rules shall govern the condition of all Seekonk Speedway events, and by participating in these events, and all participants are deemed to have complied with these rules.
